City Parking Lot Located at 25 South Street
Will Close Sunday, February 4, 2018 at 11pm

The City owned parking lot at 25 South Street in downtown will close permanently on Sunday, February 4, 2018 at 11pm to make way for construction of the new Equal Rights Heritage Center.

Travelers are asked to please be advised of the following:

- Access to the downtown parking garage on Lincoln Street will be maintained throughout construction.
- The inside and upper levels of the downtown parking garage offer free 2-hour parking and affordable long term parking permits with monthly, quarterly and annual options are available.
- A new T intersection will be used at the Lincoln Street and William Street intersection. This intersection will be signed for a 3-way traffic stop. The T intersection will replace the existing curved road configuration.
- A new pedestrian crossing will connect the north side of William Street to the Parking Garage.
- Sidewalks immediately adjoining the project site will be restricted and pedestrians will be directed to use sidewalks on the other sides of streets.
- Centro bus service on Lincoln Street will remain in effect until further notice.
- Throughout construction revised traffic plans will be released as part of 2-week construction forecasts.
