Construction Schedule for the Equal Rights Heritage Center, Auburn, NY
April 8, 2018 through April 22, 2018

The City owned parking lot at 25 South Street in downtown has closed permanently as of Sunday, February 4, 2018 to make way for construction of the new NYS Equal Rights Heritage Center. The site at 25 South Street has been fenced and construction has begun. All construction work for the period of April 8, 2018 through April 22, 2018 will take place within the project site.

Travelers are asked to please be advised of the following:

- Access to the downtown parking garage on Lincoln Street will be maintained throughout construction.
- The upper levels of the downtown parking garage offer free 2-hour parking and affordable long term parking permits with monthly, quarterly and annual options are available.
- A new T intersection is now being used at the Lincoln Street and William Street intersection. This intersection is signed for a 3-way traffic stop and includes a new pedestrian crossing to connect the west side of William Street to the Parking Garage.
- A City of Auburn Crossing Guard will be stationed at the intersection of William and Lincoln Streets on school days during the morning and afternoon drop-off times for neighboring pre-schools for the remainder of the current school year.
- Five parking spaces on the east side of William Street immediately south of Lincoln Street will be designated for free short-term 15 minute drop-off parking.
- Sidewalks immediately adjoining the project site are closed and pedestrians will be directed to use sidewalks on the other sides of streets.
- Centro bus service on Lincoln Street will remain in effect until further notice.
- Throughout construction revised traffic plans will be released as part of 2-week construction forecasts.
