NYS Equal Rights Heritage Center To Open Mid-November

Construction of the NYS Equal Rights Heritage Center at 25 South Street in downtown Auburn, NY will continue for the next two weeks and a mid-November opening is expected.

"We are almost complete but a couple more weeks are needed," stated Mayor Michael D. Quill, "We thank all of our construction partners for getting this project to where it is and we look forward to be able to open soon."

Finishing touches to the building and project site will continue including the installation of a new statue of Harriet Tubman that will be placed in the courtyard area on the east side of the site.

Road and sidewalk installation will continue on Lincoln Street until mid-November. During construction the street will serve as the entrance to the downtown parking garage only. Due to road construction on Lincoln Street the upper levels of the City of Auburn Downtown Parking Garage will continue to offer free unlimited parking from now through November 30, 2018.
